



ALL-DISTRICT SUMMER SHUT DOWN

All-District Summer Shut Down was implemented in the summer of 2014 in response to the A-3 Team’s recommendation. It has proven to be successful on a number of levels. Therefore, we will continue the All-District Summer Shut Down.

The following calendar will be recommended to the Board of Education for approval on January 14, 2016, for the summers of 2017, 2018 and 2019:

The District Administration understands and supports the philosophy that our students need opportunities for off-season conditioning and skill building for athletics and for lesson and rehearsal time for music. These students also need time to decompress from a rigorous school year and have an all-district-wide time where there are no expectations for students to participate in any district activities.

The Administration also believes that it is important for coaches, directors and sponsors to have time to step away from the pressures and expectations of these school activities and recharge for the next school year.

The following list summarizes All-District Summer Shut Down procedures:

- No District 228 student activities, practices, camps, conditioning, etc. will occur
- No facilities will be rented or open to any groups
- S.A.F.E. will be closed during shut down weeks
- Only authorized school personnel will be permitted to enter any school facility

As a reminder, the summer 2016 All-District Summer Shut Down dates are July 2—July 10.
